And Withdrawal of Addendum and Signing Memorandum


This 14<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2023, the Greene County School District Board of Education (GCSD) and the Lake Oconee Academy Board of Governance (LOA) have voted upon and agreed to the following amendment to LOA's Charter Renewal Petition (Petition), which is pending before the Georgia State Board of Education, Charter Schools & District Flexibility Division (SBOE). The Petition is hereby amended as follows:

In years 3-5 of the charter, LOA may exceed the enrollment/funding cap by up to 10 students per year only for the purpose of giving priority to the children of newly hired full-time teachers, and newly hired full-time paraprofessionals.

This Amendment affects all references to the enrollment/funding cap in the LOA Petition.

Additionally, LOA withdraws its respectfully submitted Addendum and Signing Memorandum, which was filed with LOA's Petition on December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
